- Go through a paper attempting each question then watch the video to see how many marks you got and the technique used before moving onto the next. Re-attempt the paper without the aid of the video to see what you can remember (go to the "Homework" section, select "WTM library")
- Use the gap analysis tool to find strengths and areas to develop .Enter your marks for each question into a template and it will automatically colour code your feedback sheet to show you where need to focus your time (go to the "Gap analysis" section, select our exam board).
- Stuck on a particular question, you can watch one of the 152 video tutorials to assist you in moving forward.
- Look at the Walking Talking Marks library. These are targeted at grade 4-5 and 7-9 students. Download the question, attempt it and then review the worked solutions. Look at the attached video for each question so you can hear what an examiner is looking for in terms of method and answers.
- Furthermore, you can also use the PiXL Times Table app to practice times tables in a fun and competitive way and will allow your child to focus on strengths and weaknesses.

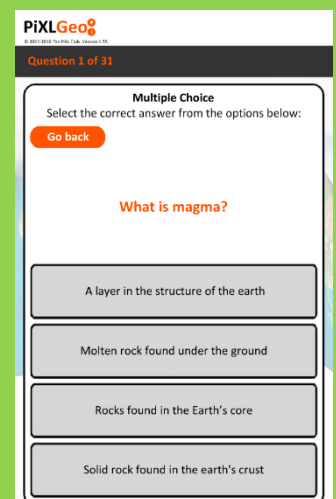
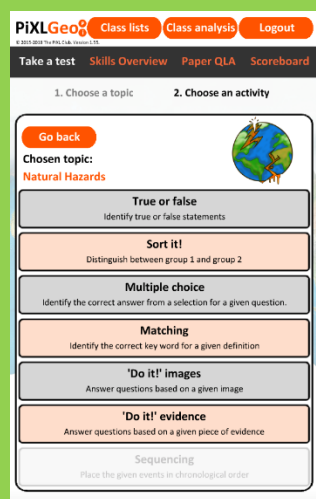
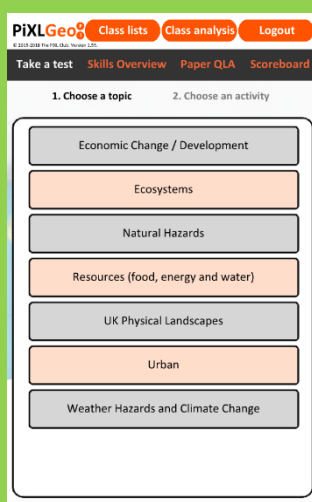
- Choose the 'Take a test' option which will give your child five different revision tasks:
- **Task 1. Quotation learning.** This helps your child to remember key quotes from the text and who said them. This is a vital part of revision due to the closed book exam rules.
- **Task 2. Character Learning.** Your child will need to select the theme/topic that the quotation relates to. This is very useful revision as the exam questions will most likely be character or theme focused.
- **Task 3. Play your quotes right.** This focuses on quotation learning but gets you to think about the order of the quotations. This will help your child choose the best quotations in relation to the question.
- **Task 4. Events and happenings.** This game tests your knowledge of the text as a whole, which is an important part of revision as your child will be required to refer to the whole texts in their exam responses.
- **Task 5. Literature terminology.** This tests your child's knowledge of key linguistic devices and will also stretch their range of vocabulary to use terminology specific to the text.
- Answers will be marked correct with a green tick or incorrect with a red cross; where incorrect your child will be given the correct answer to the question but will be asked it again to check they have remembered the correct answer.
- In order to check your child's progress through the revision tasks you can select 'Skills overview' from the menu for each text. This screen will show you how many questions your child has answered correctly for each game.

- Your child should use the app to check their understanding across the range of activities by selecting the “take a test” and then choosing a topic.
- These activities are:
 - a) True or false/ Multiple choice – assesses raw knowledge of key skills
 - b) Sort it – assesses reasoning
 - c) Matching – assesses key words against definitions
 - d) Do it images/evidence – assesses the ability to analyse given information
 - e) Sequencing – assesses knowledge of a sequence of events
