
Dear Parent/Carer

RE: Returning to School - September 2021

We are very much looking forward to welcoming back the full school community over the coming days. We are aware that some people have experienced delays in receiving orders from our uniform suppliers. This may mean that your child does not have all the required uniform for their return. Please let your child's Achievement Leader know if this is the case.

Further to the communication sent out in the summer I would just like to share a few reminders:

This year we will return to all students wearing FULL school uniform every day and changing into their PE kit for PE lessons. This means we expect ALL students to wear school shoes and NOT TRAINERS for school every day. Blazers are expected to be worn every day with a school coat big enough to be worn over the blazer (denim and leather jackets are not permitted). Hoodies must not be worn. Jewellery is not permitted except for an inexpensive watch and ONE small stud per earlobe (facial piercings and piercing retainers are not permitted). Nail varnish, gel polish or acrylic nails and eyelashes must not be worn.

Mobile phones are not to be seen or heard in school. This means they must be turned off and stored in the students bag for the duration of the school day. Students should not rely on them for telling the time. If a student is seen using their mobile phone or it disrupts the flow of a lesson because it goes off, it will be confiscated by the teacher and a 30 minute after school detention will be issued for the following day.

The times of the school day will return to 8:45 start and 3:05 finish for all students and entrance and exits will be through the main gate and side gate. If students are late they will receive a lunch time detention that day.

Thank you for your ongoing support and we look forward to supporting your child/ren through what we hope will be a more normal school experience this year.
