Dear parent/carer

I am writing to you with regards to the end of year arrangements for your child as they come to the end of Year 11 at Christ the King CVA.

Your child will have a Year 11 leaver's celebration on Friday 13th May. During that morning, the students will take part in a liturgy, have a celebration with their year group where food will be provided, and undertake other celebratory activities. The celebrations will finish at the end of the morning and students will be expected to be off site by 12.00pm.

Following the leaver's celebration, we are expecting your child to attend lessons as normal until they have completed the exams in that subject. We have created a bespoke revision timetable which will support your child through the exam period, and we believe this is particularly important due to the large amount of learning time lost due to Covid-19. This timetable will be shared with students and parents next week, but in essence, it involves your child attending school as normal until the week commencing 13th June. The only time this will differ is after an afternoon exam, where your child will be allowed to leave the school site upon completion of their exam.

We firmly believe that your child will benefit from remaining in school and attending revision based lessons led by the teachers who know what areas they need to develop prior to the final exam. In the morning prior to a 9am exam, a number of subjects will be offering breakfast revision sessions in order to support your child immediately prior to the exam that is taking place. This information will be shared with your child by the subject teachers who teach them.

Year 11 results day takes place on Thursday 25th August and further information about the format of the day will come out in due course.

Finally, I wanted to thank you for your support over the past five years. For those of you who have children who are leaving us, please keep in touch to let us know how your child has progressed. For those of you whose children are staying on at Sixth Form and remaining part of our community, I look forward to working with you in the next part of your child's journey.
