I am writing to you with regards to the end of year arrangements for your child as they come to the end of studying at Christ the King CVA.

Your child will finish their time with us on Thursday 12th May. During that morning, the students will take part in a liturgy, have a celebration with their year group where food will be provided, and undertake other celebratory activities. The celebrations will finish at the end of the morning and students will be expected to be off site by 12.15pm.

Following the leaver's celebration, we are expecting your child to attend lessons as normal until they have completed the exams in that subject.
