Your child is invited to attend the second Geography fieldwork visit taking place on **Monday 26th September 2022** at Burbage Brook in the Peak District. We will be collecting data for Unit 3 of the GCSE exam (geographical applications) which requires students to write about their experiences of collecting, presenting and interpreting data as part of a physical geography study.

The coach will leave at 8:00am and return at 4:30pm approx. Students will need comfortable walking shoes and wellington boots as they will be working **in** a river examining how meanders are formed. Students should dress appropriately for the weather, and therefore we would advise checking the forecast on the morning of the trip. Sun cream is advised if the weather is forecast to be sunny as some areas are quite exposed. Students will require a packed lunch as there are no facilities to buy food.

As your child is entitled to the Pupil Premium, the cost of the visit will be paid by the school upon receipt of the consent forms. If your child requires a pair of wellington boots to be provided, please could you indicate their boot size on the form below?

This is a great opportunity for your child to engage in a unique experience and to develop their knowledge and understanding of the challenging aspect of this course at the same time.
