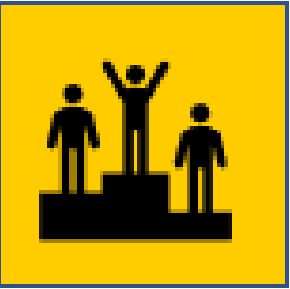
Reflection - Community

- What can you do to improve your learning?



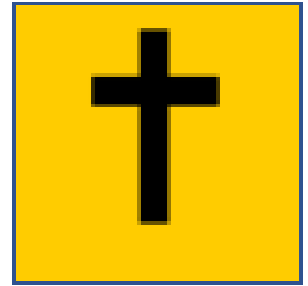
Reflection - Respect

In the section of your planner for this week's Act of Worship make a note of your commitment to improve your actions in one area of our mission statement.

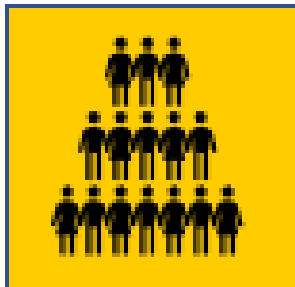
Here are some examples
