As a student, I will:

- Ensure my attendance does not fall below 95%.
- Be punctual for tutor time and all lessons.
- Be well organised and prepared for all school-based lessons and activities.
- Maintain high standards of behaviour, respect the school environment and act as a
 positive role model within the school community and beyond.
- Dress sensibly, appropriately and modestly, mindful of younger students in the community.
- Use my mobile phone discreetly and only within Sixth Form areas.
- Inform the school office of any unplanned absences before 8:30 am on the day of absence.
- Contact my class teachers when I am absent to lessons and catch up on any missed work.
- Display a positive attitude to learning.
- Respond positively to feedback and use it to support my progress.
- Use independent study time effectively to complete work, consolidate learning and prepare for future lessons, utilising the common room, Sixth Form Independent Study spaces and the LRC.
- Sign in and out of school and only leave the site during break and lunch times.
- Conduct myself in a way that role models to younger students the expected values and behaviours of Christ the King community.

As a school, we will:

- Provide a well-organised, caring environment where all staff and students feel safe and secure.
- Deliver engaging and challenging lessons that meet the needs of each student and support progress.
- Set appropriate work when a member of staff is absent.
- Provide personalised, meaningful feedback to ensure all students know their strengths and how to improve.

- Deliver timetabled CPSD and Tutor Time programmes to prepare students for the next stages of their learning and life, enabling them to live through Catholic and British values as citizens of the wider world.
- Monitor student progress, effort and attitude, offering support to help students reach their potential.
- Assign a Form Tutor to support and guide student progress and wellbeing.
- Communicate effectively with students and parents to support student needs.
- Celebrate success, effort and excellence.

As a parent/carer, I will work in partnership with the Sixth Form to:

- Support the Catholic ethos and Mission Statement of the school.
- Support my son/daughter to achieve their full potential.
- Ensure my son/daughter dresses appropriately and in line with the Sixth Form Dress Code.
- Encourage high standards of behaviour and attendance.
- Encourage my son/daughter to use independent study time and catch up on missed work.
- Avoid planning holidays during term time.
- Inform the school of any changes in family circumstances or issues that could affect my child's learning.

Appearance and Dress

- Students are expected to dress sensibly and appropriately, setting an example to the rest of the school. One smarter outfit is recommended for public events, interviews and Mass.
- The following are considered unacceptable:
 - Clothing with inappropriate slogans.
 - Revealing clothing, including low-cut tops, cropped tops, or transparent fabrics.
 - Very tight-fitting clothes.
 - Skirts or shorts that are well above the knee.
- All sixth form students must wear their ID badge with the provided lanyard visibly around their neck as this is a legal requirement.
- The above list is not exhaustive. The Sixth Form Team will make judgements based on individual cases. Students deemed inappropriately dressed may be asked to go home to change.
